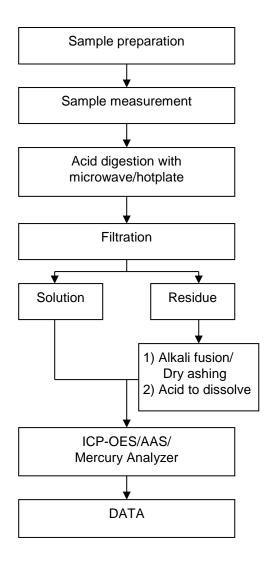

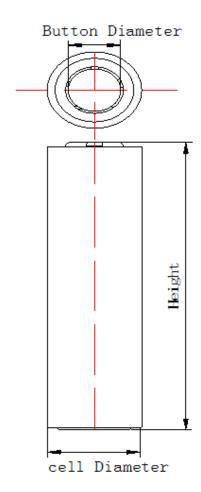

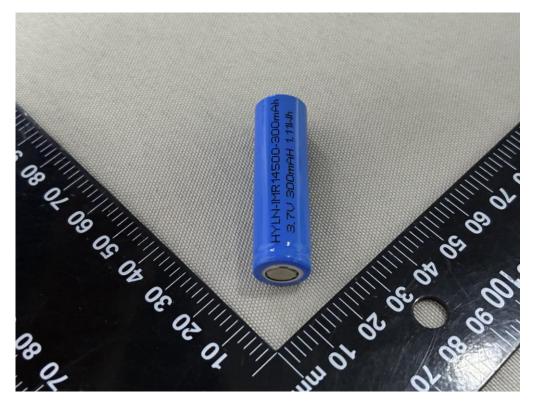


Figure 8 Side view of cell (IMR14500-300mAh)
